

Venue

Taipei Nangang Exhibition Center, opened in 2019, is located at the northeast corner of Taipei City and is only a 15-minute commute via the metro or by car. It is the first exhibition hall in Taiwan to be awarded the "Green Building Label – Golden Level". The center offers 156,700 sqm floor space to accommodate 32,000 visitors for exhibitions, conferences, business meetings and events. The Congress will take place in the brand new exhibition hall 2, Skyline Convention Centre on Floor 7.

Hotel

Grand Hyatt Taipei is the only Taipei hotel with a direct link to Taipei's iconic landmark skyscraper, Taipei 101.
