Why Carbon footprint?

- > WAN-IFRA's global initiative to reduce the environmental impact of newspapers
- Countries signed Paris agreement to reduce CO2 footprint , that impose stricter laws on industries.
- Helps to optimize cost by managing consumption of power, materials
- Sell better : Many international advertisers have an environmental policy

Objectives:

- Annual GHG emission by the printing plant
- Knowledge transfer and training
- Consultation and audit to identify the potential project scopes in the site





What? How?

> GHG Emission for printing plant will be calculated based on annual data

- Three scope of emissions
 - Scope 1 emissions are direct emissions from owned or controlled sources.
 - Scope 2 emissions are indirect emissions from the generation of purchased energy.
 - Scope 3 emissions are all indirect emissions (not included in scope 2),
- Identify top contributors within the process



Why WAN-IFRA? Why not any?



GHG Emission Certificate: Highly valued certificate from WAN-IFRA for the newspaper industry.




